Dear Mr. Chair,

Thanks for giving me opportunity.

The Hmong Indigenous, a people who have lived in Laos more than 2000 BC ( Earth Planet 72). We have had our own language, written letter and religion.

The Hmong people in Laos have been discriminated by the Lao PDR and they have been forced into the Jungles since 1975 with no education, no foods, and medicines to supply and provide to their children . These people have no choice, but they live in the Jungle and eat leaves not like human being as you and us. Also, the Lao PDR government called those people are Bandits and God (Chaofa) that is why the Hmong people were hunt by Lao PDR and Vietnamese troops in daily.

After the CERD Community on Feb. 21 and 22, 2005 in Geneva, our sources reported from February to May 16, 2005 there were 250 people including children and women had died. Most of them died from starvation, chemical biological, and military forces.

Also, many Hmong boys and girls who live in Lao Cities, must change their names to Laotiane names, if not, they are not allowed to attend the high education.

To my understanding, this is a RACE GENOCIDE & DISCRIMINATION against the Hmong race. We would like to ask you and all UN members and international Community for advices:

How can we help to provide education for Hmong indigenous in an area restricted by the Lao PDR. When any one go there they get arrest?
