Thank you Chairman Mr. Philip Taura, distinguished representatives of the Permanent Forum, thank you for this opportunity to address on future work,

I am addressing the Permanent Forum on the item of future work in the case of the ongoing occupation of the in 1961 declared West Papua Melanesia state.

Ever since in the period of 1962-1963 United Nations UNTEA / UNSF took over control of our state, there has been no UN involvement anymore ever since in 1963 the Indonesia army took over control and started genocide on the West Papua people. Please see link:

The conflict threat in West Papua is imminent. This has been concluded by US ambassador to Indonesia Mr. Robert Blake on his recent visit in March 2016, witnessed sever

oppression of the West Papua people and Islamic Jihad threat in all regions of West Papua Melanesia.

In the US Congressional year 2007- 008 the US Congress Consolidated Appropriations bill (HR 2764) (December 18, 2007) issued by Congress members Mr. Donald Payne and Mr. Eni Faleomavaega and the Congressional Black Congress for restoring the responsibility of the United States of America to correct the decisions made by the Kennedy administration back in 1962 to deny West Papua Melanesia's right to political independence, which have led to today's genocide under West Papuans committed by the occupying state of Indonesia.

Indonesian elite military Kopassus Units since last week 11 May at the regions of Sorong, Biak, Manokwari, and at the Freeport Gold, Uranium and copper mining area of Tenbaggapura and the Grassberg mine elite military. In Manokwari the TNI military troops have increased to 10.00 soldiers armed forces to protect the new to be built Muslim Mosk against the protests of the Christian community of West Papuans.

We ask the Permanent Forum to recommend on the following on future work:

- Urgent United Nations action to stop the genocide in the since 1962 occupied West Papua Melanesian nation state.
- Urge the Unites States Congress to carry out 2008 Consolidated Appropriations bill (HR 2764) (December 18, 2007) which urges the US Obama or following administration on the decolonization of West Papua.
- Urge the United Nations to act immediately via the Human Rights Upfront initiative to protect the Christian West Papua community from Islamic Jihad threat on the recommendations given by UN Undersecretary General Jeffrey Feltman at the International Peace Institute.
