UN Special Rapporteur on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples Ms Tauli-Corpuz,

In 1962 the Philippines and Australia voted to subjugate West Papua with UN troops, a colonization option permitted by UN Charter articles 81 & 85 part 1. But in violation of our legal obligations (Charter articles 76, 88, 103) we are allowing the indigenous Papuan people under our subjugation to be criminalized for demanding their lawful article 1 & 76 rights while our governments BLOCK the operation of Charter articles 85 part 2, 87 & 88 by refusing to add the issue of our UN authorization General Assembly resolution 1752 (XVII) to the agenda of the Trusteeship Council so that the Council can commence its unfinished business of making the yearly reports about our UN colony of West Papua a.k.a. West New Guinea a.k.a. Irian Barat a.k.a. Irian Jaya a.k.a. additional names used in an attempt to confuse the outside world about the identity of this Pacific territory under Asian and UN subjugation.

Will you please ask the Secretary General to exercise his right under rule 7 of the 1995 Trusteeship Council rules of procedure by adding the issue of UN General Assembly resolutions 171 & 1752 to the agenda of the Trusteeship Council?

My government and others are in business with the government that is unlawfully exploiting the homelands and oppressing the people of West Papua, so I plead for your and the Secretary General's assistance - the lives & liberty of the indigenous West Papuan people depend on the UN Trusteeship protocol of Charter article 85 part 2 being exercised.
