New Zealand was also a co-sponsor of the resolution made by Bolivia for the World Conference on Indigenous people in 2010, and New Zealand looks forward to participating in the World Conference in 2014. In particular, we welcome the opportunity to share perspectives and best practices on the realisation of the rights of indigenous peoples, including their rights to pursue the objectives of the Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (the Declaration).

We understand that the World Conference is a high level plenary meeting of the General Assembly with participation expected by all GA member states.
