Respected president, I'm Jia Chunyang, from China Institutes of Contemporary International Relations(CICIR), and I am speaking on behalf of the China Foundation for Human Rights Development (CFHRD).

As we all know, after the Europeans arrived in North American, they soon began to expel and massacre the Indigenous Peoples on a large scale. After its establishment, the United States continued to expel, massacre, or forcibly assimilate Native Americans. As a result, the Indian population in the United States plummeted from 5 million at the end of the 15th century to 250,000 at the beginning of the 20th century. At the same time, the United States also forced the assimilation of Indians by opening Indian boarding schools, which may directly or indirectly lead to the death of as many as 40,000 Indian children. Today, the Native Americans still have not obtained the same social, economic and political rights as white people, So that they have become "forgotten people".

Therefore, I hope the United States can formally recognize its genocide policy against Native Americans. And suggest the international

community to form an independent investigation team to investigate the genocide suffered by Native Americans and the current racial discrimination they face.
