Under rule 7 of the 1995 Trusteeship Council rules of procedure, please, will you ask the Secretary General and others to place the issue of West Papua, the issue of General Assembly resolution 1752 on the agenda of the Trusteeship Council?<sup>1</sup>

Fifty-six years ago, the General Assembly authorized foreign occupation of West Papua but did not put the issue of that authorization on the agenda of the Trusteeship Council.

And so, for fifty-six years the Council has been unable to commence the yearly reports to the General Assembly about the progress of West Papua and its indigenous population.<sup>2</sup>

Our indigenous rights to life, liberty and prosperity have been in the hands of the General Assembly since 1962 and as a son of West Papua, I am asking you, please allow the Trusteeship Council to commence the duties which the Charter of the United Nations article 85 part 2, and article 88 requires of that Council.
